

Our Program

In 2000, founder Cindi Wagner left her employer and salary to launch a healing center for women who are recovering from addiction or looking for a jail alternative, providing a one-year residential program to tear down their walls of fear and hopelessness and learn how to become productive members of society. She incorporated this residential program as Tabitha Ministry in 2001, naming the ministry after the biblical disciple Tabitha, who was known for doing good and was raised from the dead (Acts 9:36-42).



Tabitha Ministry houses 6 women at a time. Residents take morning & evening Christ-based classes that teach them how to change their thinking and restore their dignity & identity. Residents also work in the ministry's thrift store, Tabitha's Closet, as community service, where they develop professional skills they can use in the workforce after graduation.
