Tabitha's Closet: Cindi's Legacy

When Cindi started Tabitha Ministry in 2001, she needed a way to fund the ministry. While she would reach out to donors in the local community for financial support, she also needed a way to build sustainable funding. Enter Tabitha's Closet.





Tabitha's Closet is an integral part of the Tabitha Ministry program for a number of reasons. In addition to providing people in the community with access to high quality, inexpensive clothing, housewares, and other items, it provides a place for the community to come together to support the residents. We have customers who have been visiting the store for over a decade to pour their love into the ladies and get to know them as individuals.

Residents are not paid to work in the Closet. Instead, they give 20 hours of community service each week as part of the program, which helps them build customer



service skills. As residents graduate from the program and reenter the workforce, they are able to apply the skills they develop.

Cindi handpicked Melanie Todd to manage and run the Closet. Melanie was a long-time volunteer in Tabitha's Closet.
