Since our last newsletter, this time has been a bit of a rollercoaster season. Things we thought we were sure of, turned into uncertainty. We have gained and lost, but through it all, God was in the midst. He taught us many lessons, but especially not to lean on our own understanding. When we were sure we had the plan, God turned it upside down.

Thank you to all of you who have generously donated to our building campaign. We are getting antsy for the new construction to begin, but every time we think we have a direction, we encounter another roadblock. Pray for God's release, timing, and direction. We may need to alter the purpose of the new building, but we are asking for God to show us what we need as opposed to what we want.

To make a long story short, the owner of the property that Tabitha Ministry hoped to purchase has decided not to sell. Without two adjacent lots, Tabitha Ministry will not be able to build a new resident house as we had hoped that spans both lots, so we are considering another plan. One option being considered is building a smaller structure on the vacant lot that the ministry already owns with a large multi-purpose room that can be used for classes, graduations, and other ministry events.

On an encouraging note, one of our newest ladies went to court, and our judicial advocate said it was a first for her after many court appearances. Our resident received two ovations from many people in the courtroom, and the judge actually left the bench to come down and give her a hug and tell her how proud he was of her. This is a reminder of why we do what we do.



On another bright note, after a long process, we were finally able to move the Department of Transportation fence outside of Tabitha's Closet back a couple of feet. While 24 inches might not sound like much, traffic flow has greatly improved!

Our Father's Love Banquet, with silent auction, is coming up October 10th and will be a time of reflecting on the reality of life, recovery, and walking out God's plan even in the trials. We have already received some exciting donations, including a flat screen smart TV, to auction off that evening. We really hope to see you there!
